RULES AND REGULATIONS

HORSE SHOW OFFICE HOURS: The horse show office will close one hour before each performance. Entries for classes within a performance should be made prior to that closing. Check posted hours for additional closings.

EXPRESS CHECK-IN: Tuesday 10am-5pm and Wednesday 9am-noon for exhibitors whose entries are complete. Incomplete entries will not be processed during Express Check-In.

\$35 CHARGE FOR INCOMPLETE ENTRIES: Entries not containing all necessary documents to verify eligibility for horse/rider/owner/trainer/handler will be considered incomplete. Copies of registration papers showing proof of current ownership or lease, copies of current USEF, ASHA and ADHHA membership cards must accompany entry blanks, which must include the REQUIRED three signatures and complete addresses for owners and trainers.

OPEN CHECK: To facilitate office procedures, all exhibitors/trainers will be required to leave a blank signed check in the show office before numbers will be released.

CREDIT POLICY: If there is a history of returned checks or declined credit cards with an exhibitor, they are required to remit payment in the form of cash, cashier's check or certified check to MAHSA for any current and future show fees. If using a credit card they must pay the open balance prior to the start of the show. Otherwise cash only will be accepted at the end of the show to close out account.

CREDIT CARD PAYMENTS: All credit card charges are subject to a 4% processing fee.

REFUNDS: Exhibitors cancelling entries after closing date without a vet certificate shall forfeit their entry fees. NO REFUND OF STALL RENT, OFFICE OR FEDERATION FEES. No refunds will be made during the show.

FAILURE TO ENTER/SCRATCH: A \$25 fine will be charged to any exhibitor who fails to enter or fails to scratch an entry at least one hour prior to the start of the performance in which the entry would compete.

ALL STABLING IN ENCLOSED BARNS: Stalls will be available Tuesday. Earlier stabling is an additional \$10/day/stall. Unless a horse is entered, it may not occupy a stall until all competition horses are accommodated.

US EQUESTRIAN FEDERATION MEMBERSHIP STATEMENT

Life, senior active and junior active members shall be eligible to participate in all classes at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions at the Modified Level or above and Combined Driving Competitions at the Advanced Level, Dressage, Reining and Vaulting Competitions and Endurance Rides. A nonmember may participate as a handler, rider, driver, owner, lessee, agent, coach or trainer at Regular Competitions, Eventing Competitions, Dressage Competitions, Reining Competitions and Combined Driving Competitions upon payment of a \$45 Show Pass fee. Participants in the following classes are exempted from the Require-

ments of this rule: 1) leadline; 2) exhibitions; 3) games and races; 4) classes for 4-H members; 5) walk trot (exception: Friesian performance FR222) and academy classes (academy classes are classes limited to horses used regularly in a lesson program); 6) USDF introductory level tests, pas de deux and quadrille classes; 7) NRHA Endorsed Reining Competitions. 8) Opportunity classes, 9) citizens of other nations who have proof, in English, of current membership in good standing of their own National Federation, 10) USEA beginner novice division; and 11) assistant handlers in Dressage Sport Horse Breeding classes. Whether member or non-member, all amateurs must possess an Amateur Card issued by USEF. Back numbers will not be released until entry blank has all signatures and all required credentials have been verified by horse show office.

Reminder: All USEF Life and Senior Active members, as well as participants who have regular contact with minor athletes, are required to comply with the U.S. Center for SafeSport training requirement to be eligible to participate in the competition. All participants must adhere to the U.S. Center for SafeSport Code, USEF Safe Sport Policy, and the Minor Athlete Abuse Prevention Policies. More information about these can be found at www.usef.org.

ALL HORSES: Horses coming into Illinois must have a current Health Certificate, Negative Coggins for Equine Infectious Anemia within the prior 12 months, and proof of Rhinopneumonitis (Rhino/Flu) vaccination within 6 months of entering facility. See USEF rule: GR845 for complete rule.

UPHA CLASSICS: Open to any horse nominated and kept eligible with UPHA. Money will be added to entry fees collected and dispersed to winners in each Classic.

JUNIOR HORSE JACKPOT CLASSES IN FIVE-GAITED, THREE-GAITED, FINE HARNESS, PARK AND PARK PLEASURE: Purse money will include all class sponsorships and entry fees. 100% of the purse will be split – 50% to the owners and 50% to the trainers of all ribbon winners up to 8 places. (See page 4 for details.)

MID-AMERICA ROADSTER CHALLENGE: Purse money will include \$35,000 added money and \$400 of entry fees. (See page 9 for details.)

\$500 "JACKPOT" FIVE GAITED, THREE GAITED, FINE HARNESS AND PARK STAKES: Open to all; no qualification required. Purse money paid to owners of top five horses; trainers of top five get 50% of entry fees. Purse Distribution: \$150/\$125/\$100/\$75/\$50. "JACKPOT" CLASSES: Open to all; no qualification required.

STAKE/CHAMPIONSHIP ELIGIBILITY: Horse or pony must be entered, shown and judged in a class in the same section. To qualify for an Amateur, Ladies, Adult or Junior Exhibitor Stake/Championship, horse/pony must have been shown in a class in the same section by an amateur, lady or junior exhibitor.

The management of the Horse Show reserves the right to cancel any class(es) when there are less than four (4) entries and to combine or divide any class or classes should such be in the best interest of the show. All exhibitors will be notified of such changes before the first performance of each session.

ALL DOGS MUST BE LEASHED

Competition and Warm-up footing is sawdust and dirt on clay. Competition arena: Coliseum of Champions, 116' x 241'. Warm-up: Covered Arena 121' x 204', Barn 13 181' x 111', Barn 14 150' x 100'.

HOLD HARMLESS STATEMENT: Any and all entries in this horse show shall be conditioned upon the following terms and conditions: The Mid-America Mane Event Horse Show, Mid-America Horse Show Association, Illinois Dept. of Agriculture, show management, and sponsors will be in no case responsible for any loss, damage or injury that may occur, and it shall be a condition of entry that each exhibitor shall hold them blameless for any loss or injury which may occur by fire, theft or otherwise.

GOLF CART RENTALS: Golf carts are available for rent from the Illinois Department of Agriculture, but must be reserved in advance. Personal golf carts require a fairgrounds permit. To rent a cart or get a permit for a personal cart, contact Non-Fair Events Office at 217/782-1698.

MINOR MUST HAVE DRIVER'S LICENSE: Minors who do not have a valid driver's license which allows them to operate a motorized vehicle in the state in which they reside will not be permitted to operate a motorized vehicle of any kind including, but not limited to, golf carts, motorcycles, scooters, or farm utility vehicles on the competition grounds of licensed competitions. Minors who have a valid temporary license may operate the above described motorized vehicles as long as they are accompanied by an adult with a valid driver's license. The parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or quardian of a minor operating a motorized vehicle in violation of this rule are solely responsible for any damages, claims, losses or actions resulting from that operation. Violations of this rule will be cause for penalties against those responsible for the child committing the offense. Wheelchairs and other mobility assistance devices for individuals with disabilities are exempt from this rule. The unsafe use of personal electronic transport devices, as determined by the competition officials and management in their sole discretion, that do not require a driver's license to operate, including but not limited to segways, hover boards, and single wheeled scooters is prohibited on competition grounds. Operating such devices in areas where people gather may be deemed "unsafe use" if there is a risk of harm to others. If the operator of the device is a minor, the parent/legal guardian or individual who signs the entry blank as a parent or guardian of a minor operating the device in violation of this rule is accountable and may be subject to penalties.

CAMPER PARKING: For camping reservations please call 217-524-9894. Illinois State Fair Security of Camping Superintendent will collect fees payable to Illinois State Fair by cash or check at the designated area.

SHARPS CONTAINERS/MEDICAL WASTE: Sharps containers will be given to each barn upon check-in. Please dispose of all needles or other sharp disposable instruments in these containers. \$100 fine can be charged for improper disposal.

DIRECTIONS TO FAIRGROUNDS: The Fairgrounds is on the north side of Springfield. Exit I-55 at Sangamon Avenue West exit. Continue on Sangamon, which runs along the south side of the Fairgrounds.

- The Mid-America Roadster Challenge Class #26 is open to horses purchased at either the January 2020 or the December 2020 Mid-America Trotting Sale.
- Entries must be registered with the American Road Horse & Pony Association.
- Owners/Trainers/Drivers must be members of the American Road Horse & Pony Association.
- Minimum age for drivers is 18.
- Entries must not have shown prior to January 1, 2020.
- Entries must qualify by showing in a minimum of 4 classes at 2 horse shows.
- Winners of the Mid-America Roadster Challenge will not be eligible for future competition in this class.
- Entry fee is \$500.00.
- \$100.00 must be received with the Entry Blank. The remaining \$400.00 must be paid in the horse show office 24 hours in advance of the Class.
- All consigned horses must change ownership at the time of the sale or they will not be eligible for the Mid-America Roadster Challenge Class.
- All consigned horses eligible for the Mid-America Roadster Challenge Class cannot have been shown prior to the date of the sale.

The Good Hands Junior Exhibitor and The Good Hands Adult Finals



The Good Hands Junior Exhibitor Finals is for riders on any suitable horse who have qualified by placing 1st or 2nd in a Good Hands qualifying class. For Good Hands qualification requirements see the USEF rule book. The Finals consists of two sections: Preliminary and Championship. The Preliminary class(es) shall also serve as an elimination for the Championship and both consist of two phases – Phase 1 is rail work; Phase 2 is the mandatory workout (figure 8 at the canter, trot back to the judges, stop and back in Preliminary Section) and a workout of judges' selection in Championship Section.

From the Preliminary, judges shall select 10-15 riders to compete in the Championship. Further testing of any rider may be requested at the judges' discretion. Judging is based 40% on rail work and 60% on workout.

(Include name of show where rider qualified on entry blank.) All riders will do rail work followed by individual workouts of judges' selection and the class will be tied.
