

Mid-America Spring Fling Check List Eliminate incomplete entry fees. Utilize this check list as your guideline.

Welcome to the 2019 show season! The check list below will help facilitate your entries. Back numbers will not be issued until all information is complete. There are new rules and regulations for this year so please note the following changes: In addition to every owner and trainer, **all EXHIBITORS** must now have a current (2019) **competing ASHA** membership. (Opportunity and Walk/Trot classes exempt)

All horses entering the facility (whether exhibiting or not) must have proof of Rhinopneumonitis (Rhino/flu) vaccination within 6 months.

BEFORE YOU MAIL THE ENTRIES PLEASE REVIEW REQUIREMENTS BELOW:

 Proof of current owner registration (horse/pony)
 Proof of Negative Coggins
 Proof of Rhinopneumonitis within 6 months (every horse/pony) GR845 Equine Vaccination Rule:
Horses entering the grounds must be accompanied by documentation of Equine Influenza Virus and Equine Herpes Virus (Rhinopneumonitis) vaccinations wihin six months prior to entering the stables. Horses not in compliance with this rule may be required to leave the competition grounds upon request by
Competition Management. Documentation should consist of one of the following methods mentioned below. The frequency of vaccine administration should be per the vaccine manufacturers' or veterinarian's recommendations. It is recommended that vaccines are administered by or under the direction of a veterinarian.
 Three signatures on reverse side of entry blank
 Proof of AHHS (Hackney) current (2019) membership for every owner, trainer and junior exhibitor in Youth Medallion classes
 Proof of ASHA current (2019) competing membership for every owner, trainer and exhibitor (Opportunity and Walk/Trot classes exempt)
 Every owner, trainer, exhibitor must be a current member of Mid-America Horse Show Association
 Current address for owner, trainer and exhibitor
 Email address for trainer & owner (very important as this is how we can communicate changes and news releases to you regarding the show)
